Ministry HAPPENINGS

This year, Haggai International equipped 891 strategically positioned leaders across Asia, Africa, Latin America, and the Middle East. These leaders are now actively influencing their communities with the Gospel, contributing to Haggai's long-term goal of one million Gospel presentations by 2027. Additionally, Haggai Leaders continue to demonstrate the Gospel through the holistic witness of Jesus by confronting widespread hardship and injustice — meeting physical needs, combating discrimination, fighting hunger, opposing human trafficking, and more.

In addition, we've also seen an unprecedented number of leaders trained through national seminars — the highest in the organization's history. This growth is the result of increased staffing and strategic support aimed at revitalizing national associations. These efforts have improved organizational health and enabled stronger, more sustainable training at the local levels.

Another key development has been the investment in faculty. A total of 223 faculty members were equipped this year, including 63 who participated in the Faculty Empowerment Experience — a weeklong initiative designed to prepare faculty who had not yet been trained using Haggai's updated curriculum.

Haggai also continued the Ending Gospel Poverty project — three years of intentional holistic ministry focused on reaching every province in Mongolia. That vision is now a reality: All 21 provinces have been reached, bringing the Gospel to places where it had previously been unknown or inaccessible.

These milestones represent more than numbers. They point to lives transformed, communities engaged, and systems strengthened.

Haggai's mission — to equip and inspire strategically positioned leaders to more effectively demonstrate and present the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to prepare others to do the same — continues to move forward with focus, faith, and renewed capacity. As the organization looks ahead, this year's progress provides a strong foundation for what comes next.

The team works to ensure that the equipping process is executed with excellence and care to bring about a life-transforming encounter with God. After the HLE, the leader relations team supports their God-fueled efforts to impact their communities and nations with the Gospel.

This year is set to be an extraordinary year for the HLE. We are preparing powerful sessions across the globe to equip over 1,000 strategically positioned leaders — men and women dedicated to shining the light and love of Jesus into their spheres of influence.

The transformation we witness among Haggai Leaders from Asia, Africa, the Middle East, and Latin America continues to be remarkable. These leaders come from diverse fields — business, education, medicine, government, clergy, and nonprofits — with at least 75% serving in the marketplace, amplifying their impact where it’s needed most. Each one returns home with renewed passion and a clear vision for God’s calling on their lives, their families, their

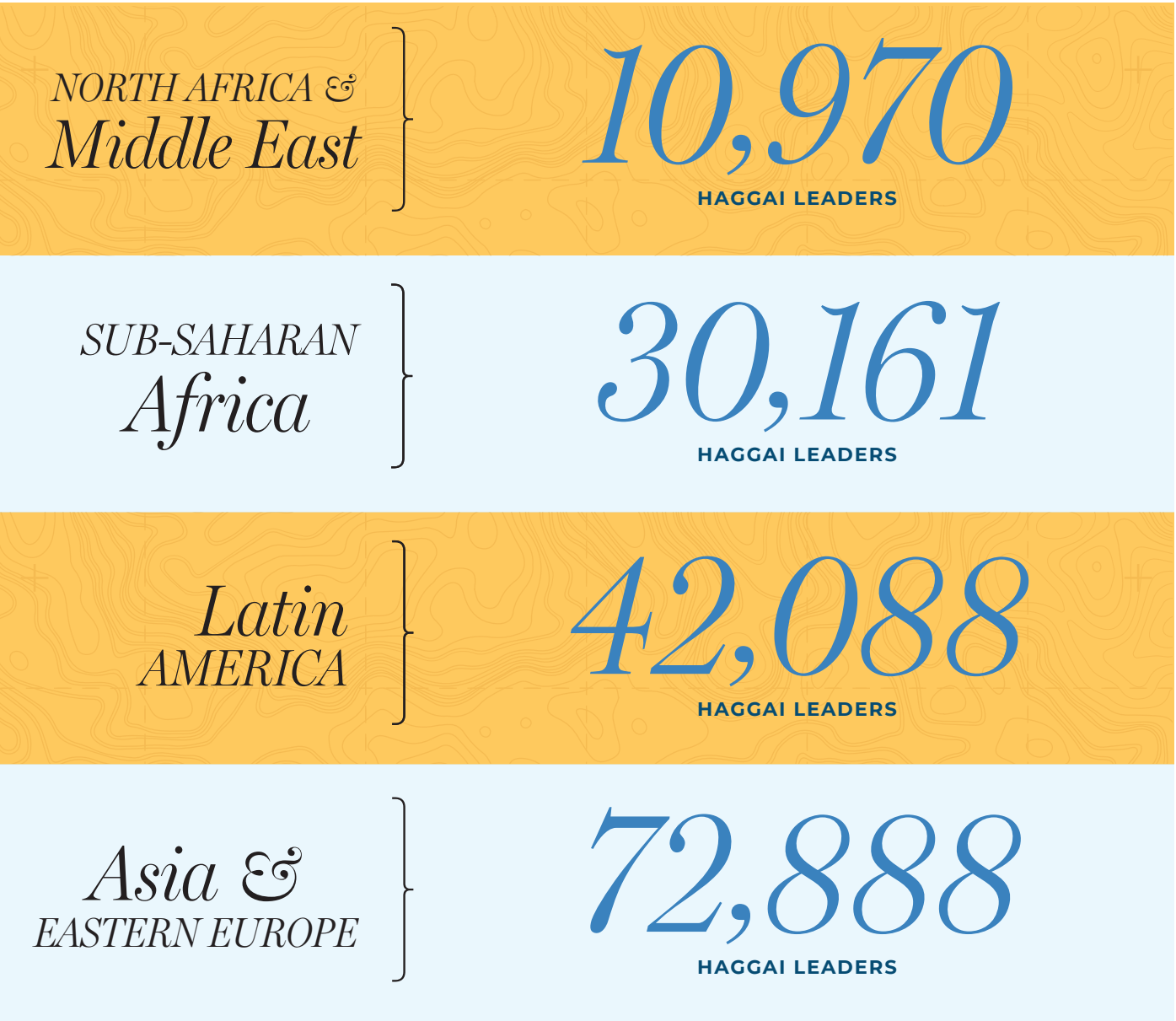

Identifying Leaders

REGIONAL REPRESENTATIVES

POSITION SUMMARY

Being a Haggai regional representative is a critical, goal-oriented ministry role responsible for recruiting numerous participants from the region for a Haggai Leader Experience (HLE) and supervising and guiding the ministries of a Haggai national association in a specific region.

ROLES

The regional representative is responsible for identifying, recruiting, and confirming leaders for Haggai International’s HLEs. This includes engaging qualified candidates, building relationships, and guiding them through the application process. They must effectively communicate program benefits,

address questions, and maintain documentation. Additionally, they organize regional marketing meetings, develop talking points, and use multiple communication methods to engage prospects. The role also involves cultivating a volunteer network to expand outreach and ensuring prospects meet program criteria. Success is measured by meeting recruitment goals and increasing the database of qualified candidates annually through proactive engagement and strategic relationship-building.

The regional representative connects new Haggai Leaders with national alumni associations, encouraging their engagement. They foster strong relationships with Haggai alumni associations’ leadership, ensuring alignment with Haggai International’s mission. Responsibilities include motivating goal-setting, monitoring national seminar quality, referring leaders for HLEs, and collaborating with churches.

Impacting the World THROUGH THE HLE

The learning department creates the curriculum and periodically updates it as per the feedback and needs of the participants. It recruits, develops, and prepares the faculty members for every session of the Haggai Leader Experience (HLE). It also innovates learning methods and incorporates appropriate learning techniques in the HLE curriculum.

The Haggai Leader Experience is the key transformational component of a leader’s journey.

In the HLE, every leader is invited into a catalytic environment which incorporates the spiritual, cognitive, emotional, social, and physical dimensions for holistic transformation through the Gospel of Jesus Christ. In the enhanced version of the HLE, strategically positioned leaders from Asia, Africa, Latin America, and the Middle East go through an experiential learning process from which they emerge as sensitive and strategic ambassadors for Christ. We continue to bring in practitioners from these parts of the world to serve, equip, and inspire the leaders through their walk and talk.

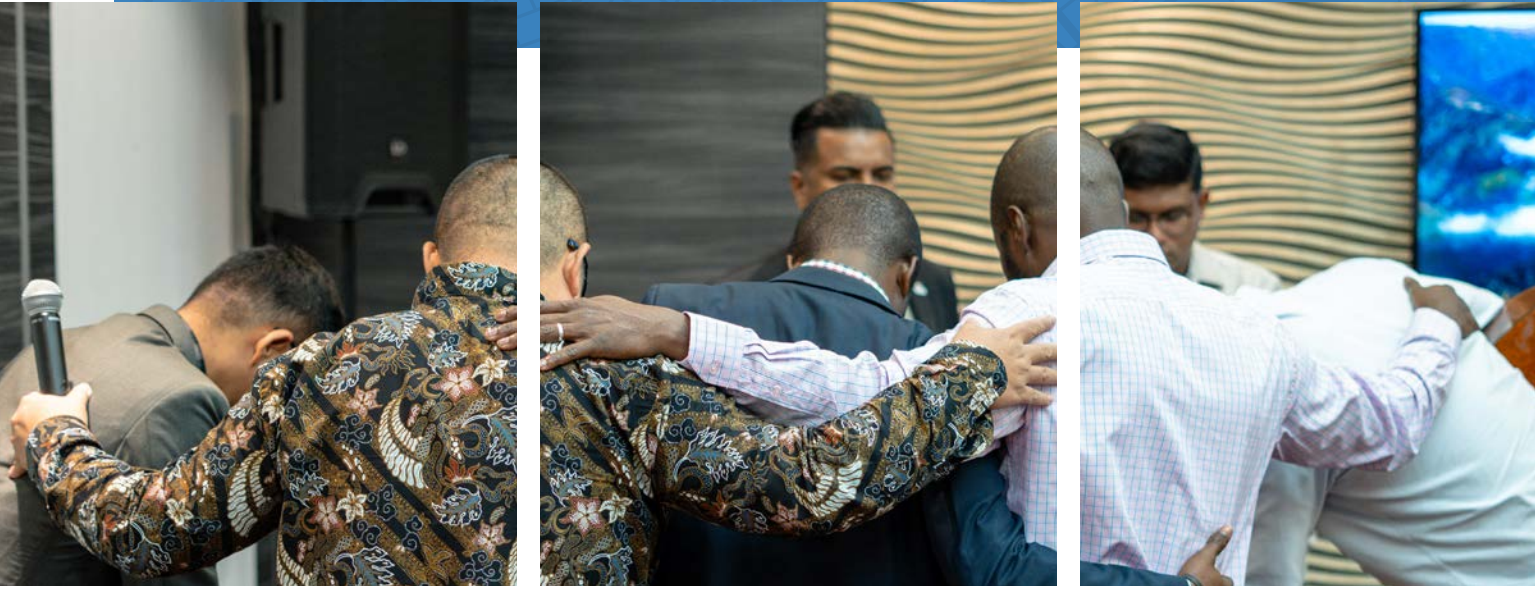
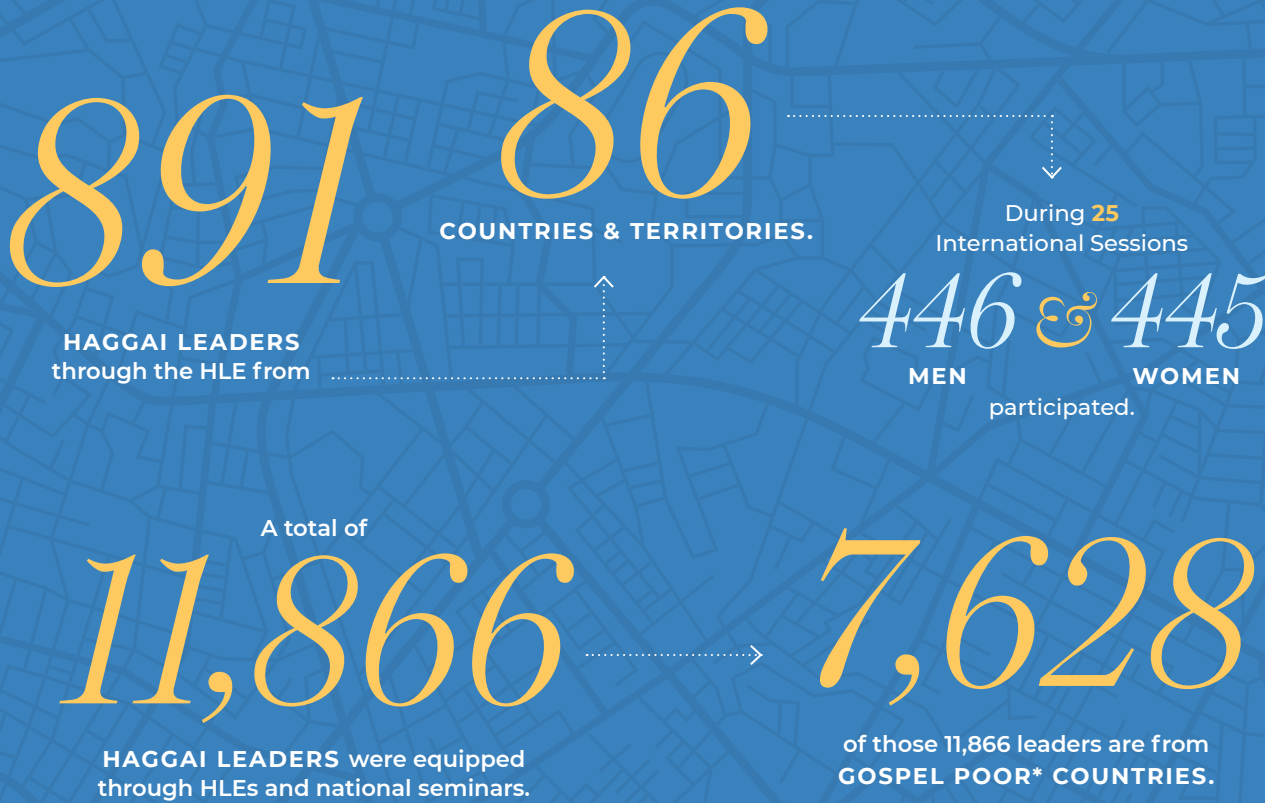
We believe in changing our methodology to address global realities and have made three notable adjustments that have increased the impact of the HLE. The first is the integration of an online learning platform, which has enabled the leader to start the journey ahead of the HLE and be able to more effectively process the learning at each step. The second is the continuous learning opportunity post-HLE that enables the leader to keep growing their impact in their sphere of influence. The third is the creation of the Equipping to Evangelize course that a leader can use to prepare others to demonstrate and present the Gospel after their HLE journey and in their own domain.

We envision the future of the HLE to be a seamless journey where the curriculum is guided by inputs from practicing Haggai subject matter experts, interwoven with emergent technology including AI, and adapted to include the next generation.

Together, we will keep equipping leaders who transform communities and nations.

National Ministries: EQUIPPING LEADERS, TRANSFORMATIONS

National ministries serve as the foundation of Haggai’s mission, empowering leaders to bring Gospel transformation to their nations. With alumni associations in 124 countries across Asia, Africa, Latin America, and the Middle East, these alumni associations actively equip leaders through national seminars, fostering Gospel impact in the marketplace, churches, businesses, education, and government. In 2024–25, over 10,700+ leaders were equipped through national seminars, with a projected 11,000 in 2025–26, solidifying our global reach.

NATIONAL MINISTRIES AT A GLANCE

- 439 total alumni associations across 124 nations
- Growth strategy: strategic partnerships with churches, institutions, ministry collaborations, and fundraising initiatives

The Asia Pacific Haggai Leaders Summit 2024 in Medan, Indonesia, embodied this impact. Themed “Ignite: Together We Can End Gospel Poverty,” the summit brought together 304 leaders from 25 countries to exchange best practices, refine strategies, and align national ministry goals. Through powerful sessions, networking, and collaborative planning, leaders renewed their commitment to advancing the Gospel.



A LIFE TRANSFORMED: BROTHER JOSHUA PRADHAN’S JOURNEY

Brother Joshua’s story exemplifies Haggai’s impact. Born into a family of a different religious faith in North-East India, he encountered Christ in college — a decision that cost him his family but gave him a purpose far greater than he had imagined. For 17 years, he has led the Siliguri City Prayer Movement, uniting churches in intercession for their city. His transformation was catalyzed in 1994 at a Haggai Leader Experience in Maui, where he embraced a leadership paradigm that reshaped his ministry. Since then, he has personally shared the Gospel with over 1,000 people, engaged government officials, and mobilized collaborative evangelism efforts. Joshua’s unwavering faith and leadership has ignited a movement of Gospel transformation across India and neighboring countries.

CONCLUSION

The year 2025 marks a significant milestone for Haggai’s mission, with strategic efforts to revitalize alumni chapters, expand national seminars and Faculty Development Seminars, and strengthen partnerships across Asia, Africa, and Latin America. Despite political and cultural challenges, the national ministry remains resilient, enhancing facilitator training, improving seminar quality, and forging church collaborations. With a sustained focus on strategic leader development, Haggai’s national ministries continue to equip them to be the hands and feet of the Gospel, advancing the mission to end Gospel poverty worldwide.

LEARNING FROM THE Leading Edge

Haggai’s new Global Insight initiative is driven by the question: How do we stay on the leading edge of God’s mission in a rapidly changing world? Our response: Learn from the leading edge. For Haggai, the leading edge is our global network of leaders promoting Gospel transformation in places of greatest need.

This last year was a “launching” year for Global Insight. We conducted surveys and ran virtual forums, one for NextGen leaders — called “Switch” — and the other gathered our most pioneering leaders from around the world. The forums revealed many things, like the growing divide between the generations in Asia, Africa, and Latin America, as well as the need for models and paradigms for engaging with emerging digital technologies. The forum also showed that many of our leaders are shifting to more holistic approaches to their work, approaches that don’t divide things like evangelism and social transformation but weave

them together to witness to the Gospel of the Kingdom through leaders’ words, way of life, and work in the world.

We’ve presented the findings at numerous gatherings, including to a group of over 300 leaders at our Asia Pacific Haggai Leaders Summit in Indonesia. After the presentation, a leader told me that “we need this information now!” to distribute through their national alumni networks. With this need in mind, we are developing our first Global Insight ebook — which will be available to all our partners around the world. In the coming year, we will have the first in-person Global Insight forum in Asia and will be launching its website, which will be a hub for all that we are learning from our network of leaders.

Becky and Dave may never meet the people reached through their giving — but they know the impact is eternal. “Haggai is one of the most effective ministries we know when it comes to carrying out the Great Commission.”

For more than three decades, Becky Wallis has been a faithful friend to Haggai International — first as a team member, now as a committed partner alongside her husband, Dave.

“I came to Haggai over 30 years ago and was immediately struck by the organization's integrity and commitment to stewardship,” Becky shares. “Every dollar was used with purpose — to advance the mission.”

Her professional background gave her a front-row seat to the ministry's operations. As accounting manager and later controller, she worked closely with board

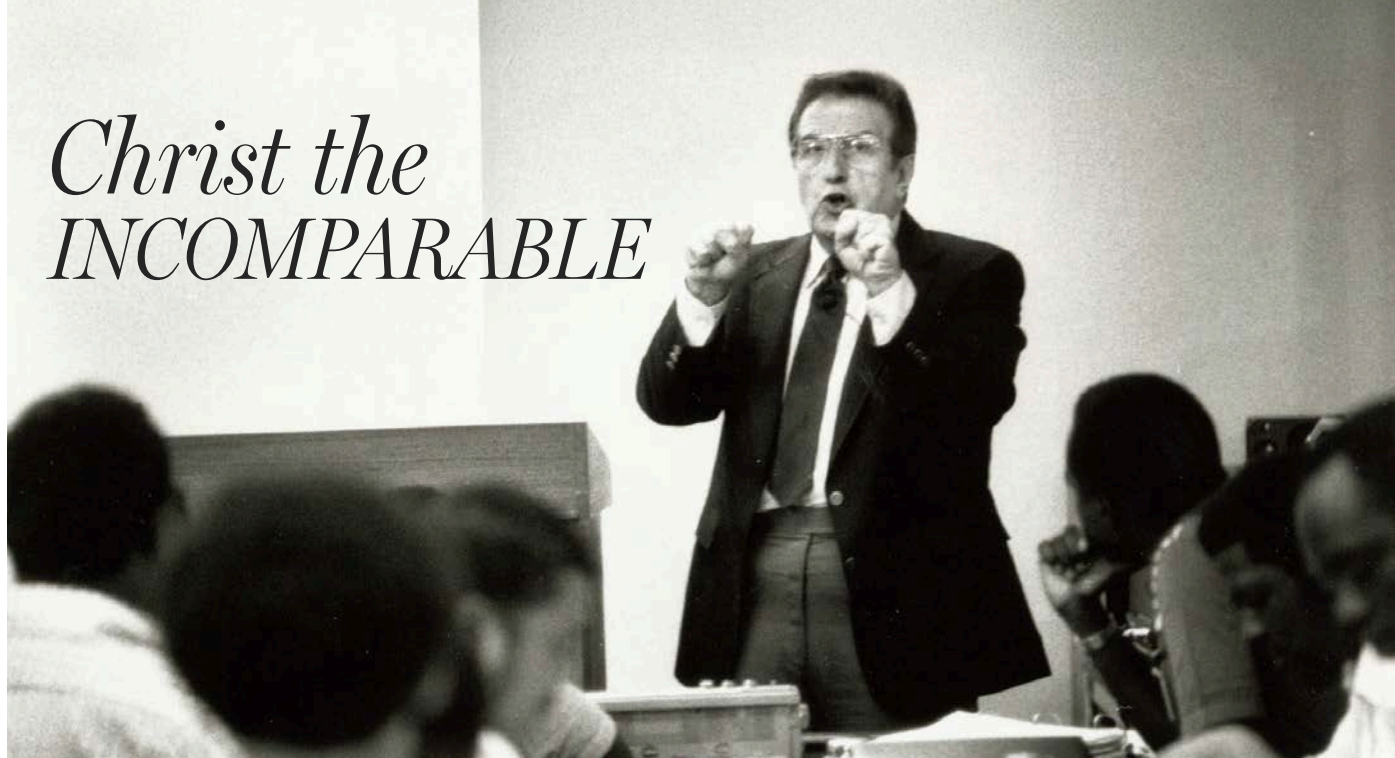
